DETAILS REGARDING SYLLABUS & SCREENING TEST

The syllabus & other details of the test will be as under :-

The Screening Test will be held in Mumbai only. The candidate should note that the purpose of the screening test is only to short-list candidates for interview. The test will be of objective type. While assessing objective Type answer sheets no penalty mark will be deducted for wrong answers marked by a candidate in his/her answer sheet. Only correct answers given by candidate will be considered for valuation purpose.

Detail of the Screening Test:- The Screening Test will consist of a single question paper of the objective type.(i.e.having multiple-choice questions). The question paper will carry maximum 150 marks and contain 150 question. It will be of one and half hour duration. The question paper will be set in **Marathi** only.

The Syllabus for the test will be as follows

- (1) Matters taught in the syllabus of the B.ED. Degree course.(40 marks)
- (2) Matter connected with teaching at Secondary School and inspection of Schools.(40 marks)
- (3) General Studies :- History of modern India(Special reference to Maharashtra) Geography of India(Special reference to Maharashtra) Indian political system-structure, powers & functions pertaining to administration of state and Local Self-Government (Rural and urban), Indian Economy, General Science, Current events of national and international importance.(50 marks)
- (4) Questions to assess the intelligence of the candidates.(20 marks)

Candidates who are eligible and whose applications are complete in all respect & are accompanied by the prescribed fee will be admitted to the screening test. The date of screening test will be announced in the news papers. The venue and the time table of the Screening Test will be informed by admission letter to the candidates admitted to the Screening Test. Such letters will be issued by the Commissions office well in advance & will be sent on the address mentioned by the candidate in his/her application form. If however, candidates do not receive the admission letter prior to three days of the test, they should contact the Commission's office personally, to obtain duplicate admission letters. Duplicate letters will be issued to only such candidates who are admitted for the Screening Test. No correspondence in this regards will be entertained by the Commission. Duplicate letter will not be sent by post. Only eligible candidates in terms of this advertisement and prospectus will be admitted for the Screening Test.

Viva-voce and Personality Test :- Candidates who attain qualifying marks in the Screening Test and who are eligible for the post according to the provision mentioned in advertisement & prospectus will alone be interviewed by Commission. All such candidates will be summoned by the Commission for Viva-Voce and Personality Test which will have to attend at their own expenses at Mumbai.
