

## Method of Marking Answers on Answer Sheet

❖ Each question is followed by answers which are shown as A, B, C, D. Select appropriate answer (only one for each question) and blacken the circle completely using **Black Ball Point Pen**.





- ❖ Use only Black Ball point pen to fill the circle.
- Use of pencil is strictly prohibited
- Cutting, erasing and use of correcting fluid is not allowed.
- ❖ Do not make any stray mark on the answer sheet.
- Answer sheet should not be folded, mutilated, torn, rolled or wrinkled.
- There will be no negative marking.
- Answer sheet will not be assessed, if Name and Roll No is not written & encoded on the answer sheet.
- Only one answer sheet will be issued to each candidate.

## **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

- Admission without this ADMIT CARD will not be allowed <u>under any</u> circumstances
- Admission to the Examination hall will not be allowed after 10 (TEN) minutes of its commencement
