SYLLABUS FOR WRITTEN TEST & SKILL TEST FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF JUNIOR HINDI TRANSLATOR AT NESAC

SYLLABUS FOR THE WRITTEN TEST:

1. OBJECTIVE TYPE QUESTIONS

(i) General English
(ii) General Hindi
50 objective type questions carrying one mark each

The questions shall be to test the knowledge of the candidates in understanding the language, correct usage of words, Idioms and Phrases and also to know the candidate's ability to write the language properly and effectively.

Illustratively the questions could be in the nature of (i) Translation of words in Hindi to English and vice-versa; (ii) making sentences to bring out the difference between two similar sounding words; (iii) correct usage of grammar in sentences both in Hindi and English; (iv) Synonymous and Antonymous; etc.

2. DESCRIPTIVE TYPE QUESTIONS

Descriptive type questions consist of (i) two passages for translation from Hindi to English and vice versa, carrying 20 marks each; and (ii) expansion of a given thought (any two out of four thoughts) carrying 5 marks each.

SYLLABUS FOR THE SKILL TEST:

Skill Test will consist of two passages, one each in Hindi and English, for précis writing carrying 20 marks each and two passages for translation from Hindi to English and vice versa, carrying 30 marks each.
