SYLLABUS

GENERAL ENGLISH:

Initiation to the testing of candidates understanding of the English Language and its correct usage, his writing ability would also be tested, questions Paragraph Writing/Report Writing/Letter Writing etc. may be included.

GENERAL STUDIES:

Questions in this component will be aimed at testing the candidates' General Awareness of the Environment around him and its application to Society. Questions will also be designed to Test Knowledge of Current Events and of such matters of everyday observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person.

The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Polity, and Scientific Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

The test will also include question relating to the knowledge of PBX Board and its operations.
